COVID-19 Update – 25 <sup>th</sup> May 2021

## Hi everyone,

Please see advice below from the Ministry of Health effective 24<sup>th</sup> May 2021. There are no <u>close</u> or <u>casual</u> contact locations in NSW, however Greater Melbourne is currently considered an affected area and there are new <u>places of high concern</u>.

Any staff who have been in the Whittlesea Local Government Area in the previous 14 days should get tested and self-isolate until the results of their test are known.

This is an evolving situation and staff are encouraged to keep up to date with first contact sites by regularly checking the <u>NSW Health</u> website.

## Key points

- Exclude staff who:
  - Have been in the Whittlesea Local Government Area in the previous 14 days.
  - Have been to a <u>close or casual contact locations</u> in NSW, or New Zealand.
  - Have been in <u>places of high concern</u> in Greater Melbourne in the last 14 days.
  - Have <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u> have a fever (37. 5°C or higher).
  - Are in close contact of a person with confirmed COVID-19 and are within their self-isolation period.
  - Live in a household with a person who is currently self-isolating.
  - Are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.

Staff are reminded that it is important to continue implementing COVID-19 Safe Work Practices which include regular hand washing, maintaining social distancing, using personal protective equipment (PPE) where necessary and regular cleaning and sanitizing of Lifebridge venues and transport vehicles.
